- ▼ **Southern Nevada:** A earthquake registering 4.2 occurred at 5:34 am last Monday morning about 25 miles northeast of Beatty, within the Nevada Test Site. The quake was centered at a depth of 18 km on the northeast side of Timber Mountain in Buckboard Mesa area. There were no felt reports.
- ▼ **Markleeville region:** For the third straight week, seismic activity occurred along the southern extension of the Genoa fault zone near Grover Hot Springs. Five quakes were recorded in the 2.0 range with one event measuring as large as 3.0.
- ▼ **Mammoth Lakes region:** Activity in the Mt. Morrison seismic trend reduced to 53 events, including eight 2.0s. A quake registering 3.4 triggered at a depth of 21 km along the northern margin of the caldera. Activity at this depth is unusual for the area.
- ▼ **Regional Activity:** A 3.2 quake occurred west of Walker and a 2.7 temblor occurred near Gabbs.
