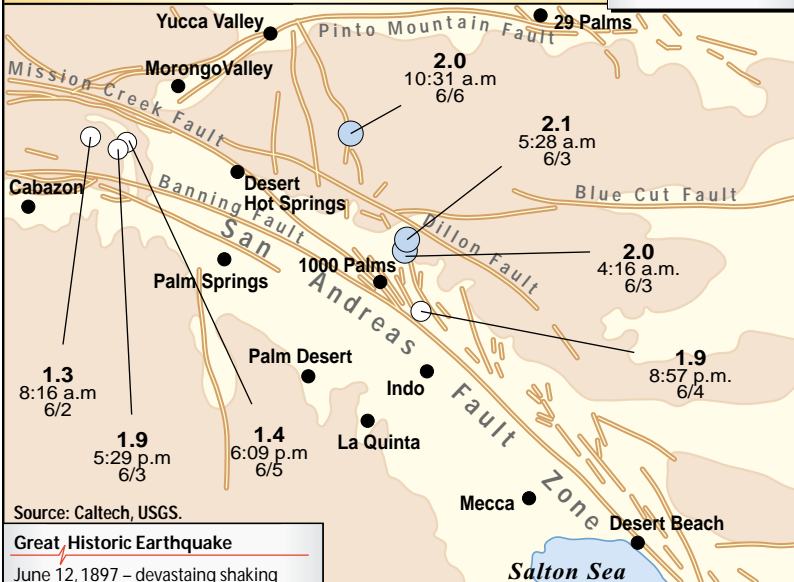
▼ The number of earthquakes in the greater Coachella Valley region declined slightly from the previous week but in doing so, fell from double-digit figures for the first time in three weeks. Three quakes measured M2.0 or stronger and extended the streak of three or more M2s to five weeks. By the way, during this period has been two quakes in the M3 range.

▼ Most notable was a pair of quakes measuring M2.0 and M2.1 on Sunday morning, June 3, along the east side of the Indio Hills north of Indio, near Pushawalla Canyon. They triggered along a splay of the San Andreas Fault which has experienced elevated activity this year. Slightly to the south and near Biskra Palms was a M1.9 tremor a day and a half later. To the northwest of Pushawalla Canyon and in the Little San Bernardino Mtns. was a M2.0 on the 6th.
